## CRIME WATCH CORNER

Recently, residents have reported unsupervised children of various ages shooting air rifles, pellet guns and similar things at passing cars, residents and animals. In several instances, residents did contact the Desk Sergeant and officers were dispatched to the Village.

We have been advised that anyone witnessing such activity should contact the Desk Sergeant at 427-1222.

Animal Care and Control was also contacted and they advised us to report any incident of someone shooting at domestic animals (dogs, cats) or wildlife (squirrels, rabbits, raccoons, etc.). ACC said that calling the Desk Sergeant would bring the quickest response.

Again, please report any incidents to the Board of Governors so we may have an accurate idea of incidents in the Village.

## GARBAGE/RECYCLE BIN STORAGE

We have received many ongoing complaints about garbage and recycle bins being stored in front of homes, garages or used as a "fence" between properties. City Code requires these bins to be stored at least ten feet back from the front corner of your home. Indian Village also requires that they be hidden behind landscaping (i.e. bushes) or a fence type panel so as not to be visible from the street. Inexpensive panels specifically for this purpose are available at Menard's, Lowes, etc. Your neighbors appreciate you hiding your bins!
